I was reading in Isaiah 36 where Sennacherib taunts Hezekiah when I spoke out loud, "I like this story God." Immediately He spoke to me, "They are not stories but lessons.. lessons to learn by." So I looked up the definition of both.

Story/Stories: an account of imaginary or real people and events told for entertainment.

Lessons: an amount of teaching given at one time: a period of learning or teaching.

In Isaiah 37 King Hezekiah had received a letter, a threatening letter from Sennacherib, King of Assyria against Israel. Hezekiah spreads the letter out before the Lord and prays. Isaiah responded to him and gave the word from the Lord but here is what God showed me about Isaiah.

Isaiah 37:21 Then Isaiah, the son of Amoz **sent** unto Hezekiah, saying, Thus said, the Lord God of Israel, where as thou hast prayed to me against Shennacherib king of Assyria:....

The key word in this verse is "sent." Isaiah was an humble man and did not see himself as so important that he had to hand deliver the message to the king in person. He was not lifted up with his own self worth, self importance. He sent a messenger with God's answer.
