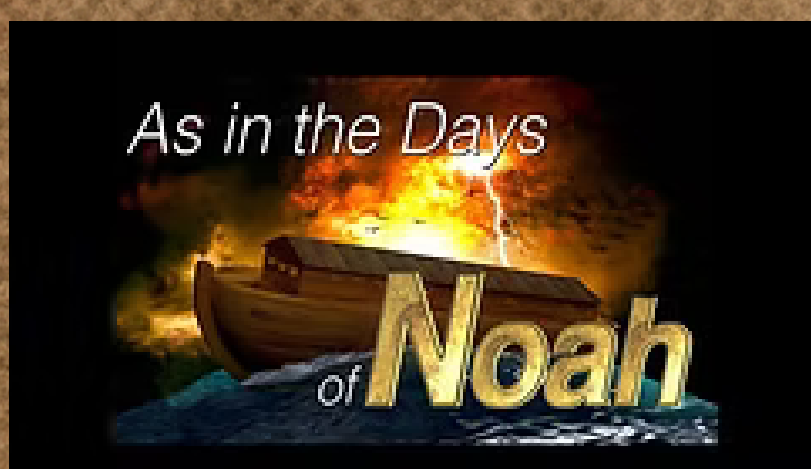

**How to Accept the Lord Jesus Christ
into your life. And to keep him
in control of your life.**

So the Holy Spirit has laid this upon my heart and mind. To share with you how to do this and how easy it is to do so. I will be using the CEB translation for this lesson. So if you are reading this it means that Father God is working with you to get you to come and accept his son Jesus Christ as your Lord. It is important to specify Jesus Christ when you do this. You Honor Father God in Heaven when you do this by giving him Glory in his son's name. If you don't specify who you are referring to when you say Jesus, it literally can be anyone on earth. There are many other people called Jesus in this world all throughout history. Also repenting of your sins is something that needs to be done not just once but everytime we slip and do something wrong. No one is perfect except Lord Jesus Christ but we have the Holy Spirit to help. He will convict you when you do something wrong so that you know to repent for it. It's a walk and you have to learn to crawl before you walk. When you mature you will make fewer mistakes. You must understand this is a choice as well. It's not Love if it's not a choice. You can't be forced into making this decision and not meaning it from the heart. God the Father reads all hearts and minds and knows who is real and who is fake. How you know someone is for real is by their fruits. The fruits are the changes that God has changed in your life that people would be able to notice differently about you. Let's gather some scriptures on this to see the promise given to us and that's eternal life. So the very first Scripture that we will look at is John 6:44 drawing of the Father.

Drawing of the God the Father

John 6:44

44. No one can come to me unless they are drawn to me by the Father who sent me, and I will raise them up at the last day.

This is why I said if you're reading this most likely this is Father God's call for you to accept his son Jesus Christ as your Lord. And if you're just reading this and already have accepted his son it may be that you are supposed to share this with someone else. But now it's time to see how you accept Jesus Christ as your Lord and we will be looking at the book Romans 10:9

[Accepting Jesus Christ as your Lord](#)

Romans 10:9

9. Because if you confess with your mouth “Jesus is Lord” and in your heart you have faith that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

It's literally that easy my friends. Simply confessing that “Jesus Christ is your Lord” and believing in his death and resurrection. It's that simple but I do want you to understand why I said Jesus Christ is my Lord and not Jesus. Simply because when you say Christ you are honoring God the Father through his Son giving them both Glory and that it points to him and him alone. There are others in the Bible named Jesus which is why it's important to determine who that is. Even the disciples acknowledge who Christ is. And here is the Scriptures for both of these points starting with honoring God the Father and glorifying him. Which is Matthew 16:16 and Philippians 2:11. And then I'll show in scripture others named Jesus which is in Colossians 4:11 and Matthew 27:16.

Matthew 16:16

16. Simon Peter said, “You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.”

Philippians 2:11

11. And every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Colossians 4:11

11. Jesus, called Justus, also says hello. These are my only fellow workers for God’s kingdom who are Jewish converts. They have been an encouragement to me.

Matthew 27:16

16. At that time there was a well-known prisoner named Jesus Barabbas.

Next we need to repent. Repent means to turn away from. And that means change your hearts and lives. It's pointless to live life and keep sinning like your changing underwear. I'm not saying you won't sin but doing it knowingly and continuing to do so without repenting means you're not changed or even trying to. You receive the Holy Spirit known as the Comforter/Companion when you accept Jesus as your Lord. And when you're in the wrong you make the Holy Spirit upset and he will lead you to repentance. You're not a hypocrite when you sin and repent, how else do we learn? When you acknowledge and repent for your wrong doings you show fruit that you are changing and making the effort and people pick up on that. That's why scripture tells you to show the production of good fruits. What are good fruits and being obedient? When you do this you grow making the mistakes less in your maturity. Let's back this up with some scripture. First we look at repentance and why it's important to acknowledge it and do it. Go to the book of Acts 3:19 then the book of Proverbs 28:13. And then the practice of sinning and not changing in the book of 1 John 3:4 and verse 8. Then we will look at receiving the Holy Spirit and him comforting us in John 14:16-17 and verse 26. Then the Holy Spirit convicting us of sin in John 16:7-8. And then we will look at showing fruit in the book Matthew 7:16-20, what the fruits of the spirit are in Galatians 5:22-23, being obedient 1 Peter 1:14-16 and finally becoming spiritually mature in Ephesians 4:13-15.

Acts 3:19

19 Change your hearts and lives! Turn back to God so that your sins may be wiped away.

Importance of repentance (Mercy)

Proverbs 28:13

13. Those who hide their sins won't succeed, but those who confess and give them up will receive mercy.

Why you don't keep sinning

1 John 3:4

4. Every person who practices sin commits an act of rebellion, and sin is rebellion.

1 John 3:8

8. The person who practices sin belongs to the devil, because the devil has been sinning since the beginning. God's Son appeared for this purpose: to destroy the works of the devil.

The receiving of the Comforter/Companion (Holy Spirit)

John 14 :16-17 & 26

16. I will ask the Father, and he will send another Companion,[a] who will be with you forever.

17. This Companion is the Spirit of Truth, whom the world can't receive because it neither sees him nor recognizes him. You know him, because he lives with you and will be with you.

26. The Companion, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and will remind you of everything I told you.

John 16:7-8

7. I assure you that it is better for you that I go away. If I don't go away, the Companion won't come to you. But if I go, I will send him to you.

8. When he comes, he will show the world it was wrong about sin, righteousness, and judgment.

Matthew 7:16-20

16. You will know them by their fruit. Do people get bunches of grapes from thorny weeds, or do they get figs from thistles?

17. In the same way, every good tree produces good fruit, and every rotten tree produces bad fruit.

18. A good tree can't produce bad fruit. And a rotten tree can't produce good fruit.

19. Every tree that doesn't produce good fruit is chopped down and thrown into the fire.

20. Therefore, you will know them by their fruit.

**What are the good fruits that are being shown in
that people see in you that is mentioned**

Galatians 5:22-23

22. But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,

23. gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against things like this.

Being obedient as well

1 Peter 1:14-16

14. Don't be conformed to your former desires, those that shaped you when you were ignorant. But, as obedient children,

15. you must be holy in every aspect of your lives, just as the one who called you is holy.

16. It is written, *You will be holy, because I am holy*

Becoming spiritually mature by doing all this sinning less

Ephesians 4:13-16

13. until we all reach the unity of faith and knowledge of God's Son. God's goal is for us to become mature adults—to be fully grown, measured by the standard of the fullness of Christ.

14. As a result, we aren't supposed to be infants any longer who can be tossed and blown around by every wind that comes from teaching with deceitful scheming and the tricks people play to deliberately mislead others.

15. Instead, by speaking the truth with love, let's grow in every way into Christ,

16. who is the head. The whole body grows from him, as it is joined and held together by all the supporting ligaments. The body makes itself grow in that it builds itself up with love as each one does its part.

God is the reader of our hearts he knows the real intention behind everything we do so keep that in mind too. He does not force anyone to love him or accept Jesus Christ; he gives you the choice. Here is some more scripture to back this up as well. Here is scripture on God searching your hearts Romans 8:26-27 and here is the one for giving us the choice to love him or not with the promise of eternal life John 3:16-18

Romans 8:26-27

26. In the same way, the Spirit comes to help our weakness. We don't know what we should pray, but the Spirit himself pleads our case with unexpressed groans.

27. The one who searches hearts knows how the Spirit thinks, because he pleads for the saints, consistent with God's will

John 3:16-18

16. God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him won't perish but will have eternal life.

17. God didn't send his Son into the world to judge the world, but that the world might be saved through him.

18. Whoever believes in him isn't judged; whoever doesn't believe in him is already judged, because they don't believe in the name of God's only Son.

This is everything the Holy Spirit has led me to say. I hope this sheds light on a lot for you. And that I am praying for your Salvation and your Righteousness and that this reaches every person that it is intended to reach. God bless you in the Name of my Lord Jesus Christ.

The Call To The Weary And Burdened

Today the Holy Spirit has lead me to go the book of Matthew chapter 11 verse 28 through 30 CSB translation

Matthew 11:28 CSB

28. "Come to me, all of you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.

In this verse Jesus Christ was calling for the lost to come to him with their problems. And who were overwhelmed with this world and everyday life and he gave them peace like no other could. A true calming of storms. This is him calling out to all of us that his word still stands for us today as it did back then.

Matthew 11:29 CSB

29. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, because I am lowly and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls

Jesus meant literally but for his later generations like us. He is referring to the Holy Spirit, the teacher he is telling us to take up his yoke, "Be like him, live sin free but repenting when we do." To learn from him, learning from the Holy Spirit is like learning from a teacher at school except he has infinite knowledge and wont mislead you. Ask for a lesson and just listen. He will lead you somewhere in the bible to learn and to apply to your everyday life. You will find peace and reassurance in the lessons that he will teach you.

Matthew 11:30 CSB

30. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.

In closing he is assuring you that to follow him is easy the bible is your guidebook with the help from the Holy Spirit. He is your friend, your mentor and he will never leave you or lead you astray. That being said, the part about his burden being light is not really a burden but a request that we profess to others that "Jesus Christ is Lord." If you are shy you do not have to speak to others. Hand out tracks with scriptures in them that tell the same message you are going to profess with your mouth. It's the same thing and sometimes easier he knows your heart and intent. He is trying to win every last soul that he can for his kingdom and he does that through us.

Important issues that need to be addressed when praying!

So the Holy Spirit has led me to teach you today. On the ways that he has taught me how to pray. Let's be clear, there isn't a wrong way to pray. But there are some things that we as the church the body of Christ have not been praying for as much as we should. And these issues are overlooked by a lot of us including me as well. These other issues that we should be praying for and about are usually overlooked. Because each of us have our own wants and desires, our own needs and battles that we face and have overcome. So we tend to lack in other important issues. Like the struggles of others, their wants and desires along with their needs and battles. Were called to agree with each other for these reasons. So none of us believers are lacking. Also we could be praying for more ways to appeal to the unsaved. And praying more against the things that would hinder us from reaching them. A simple prayer to soften the hearts and minds of the unsaved and saved will accomplish a lot. Pray that when the unsaved person's time comes to make the decision to come to Christ that they hear Father God's call and don't turn away from it. Also pray for your fellow followers of Christ that they listen to the Holy Spirit's conviction when they do sin and that they would be quick to repent of that sin. These are the issues the Holy Spirit has brought to my attention and wants me to share with you. So at this time let's dive into the word and see what it tells us to do. The first place we will be looking at is Philippians 2:1-5 to show that we are supposed to be caring more for others than ourselves like Christ did when he was among us.

Imitate Christ and how he cared for others.
(CEB Translation)

Philippians 2:1-5

- 1. Therefore, if there is any encouragement in Christ, any comfort in love, any sharing in the Spirit, any sympathy,**
- 2. complete my joy by thinking the same way, having the same love, being united, and agreeing with each other.**
- 3. Don't do anything for selfish purposes, but with humility think of others as better than yourselves.**
- 4. Instead of each person watching out for their own good, watch out for what is better for others.**
- 5. Adopt the attitude that was in Christ Jesus:**

Christ was our example on how to live; he taught us to care more for others than ourselves. And be spreaders of the good news help in every way that were able as he did. That's why it's important that we pray for our fellow christians but also the unsaved that we are all called to reach. And a simple prayer praying to soften all the unsaved and saved hearts and minds of the people helps with that. Putting their well being before our own. And praying against the stronghold erected against the saved and unsaved helps with their deliverance and maturing in the faith. Let's look at some more scripture on how to soften their hearts and minds in Ezekiel 36:26 and Romans 12:2 and tearing down the stronghold 2 Corinthians 10:3-5.

Softening of the heart.

Ezekiel 36:26

26. I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit in you. I will remove your stony heart from your body and replace it with a living one.

Softening of the mind.

Romans 12:2

2. Don't be conformed to the patterns of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your minds so that you can figure out what God's will is—what is good and pleasing and mature.

Tearing down the strongholds affecting others lives

2 Corinthians 10:3-5

3. Although we live in the world, we don't fight our battles with human methods.

4. Our weapons that we fight with aren't human, but instead they are powered by God for the destruction of fortresses. They destroy arguments,

5. and every defense that is raised up to oppose the knowledge of God. They capture every thought to make it obedient to Christ.

Agreeing with your fellow brother or sister in Christ is what I want to cover next. We are told to do so and I believe if the brother and sister are acting in the will of God the Father then we are supposed to put our agreements together. We are one church, one body of Christ. And it is a struggle together with one another to endure to the end. And agreeing on the prayer will allow it to be accomplished and that

Jesus Christ is there among you overseeing that it is done. And reassurement that what is being asked in Jesus Christ's name will be done. Let's work for all the good of non-believers and believers. So let's look at scripture on agreeing with your brothers and sisters. In 1 Corinthians 1:10 then Romans 15:5-6 then 1 Corinthians 12:12-27 then we will go to Philippians 1:27 then also Matthew 18:19-20 also John 14:14 then Galatians 6:9-10

Agreeing with others

1 Corinthians 1:10

10. Now I encourage you, brothers and sisters, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ: Agree with each other and don't be divided into rival groups. Instead, be restored with the same mind and the same purpose.

Romans 15:5-6

5. May the God of endurance and encouragement give you the same attitude toward each other, similar to Christ Jesus' attitude.

6. That way you can glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ together with one voice.

We are one body of Christ although we are many but one

1 Corinthians 12:12-27

12. For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ.

13. For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—Jews or Greeks, slaves or free—and all were made to drink of one Spirit.

14. For the body does not consist of one member but of many.

15. If the foot should say, "Because I am not a hand, I do not belong to the body," that would not make it any less a part of the body.

16. And if the ear should say, “Because I am not an eye, I do not belong to the body,” that would not make it any less a part of the body.
17. If the whole body were an eye, where would be the sense of hearing? If the whole body were an ear, where would be the sense of smell?
18. But as it is, God arranged the members in the body, each one of them, as he chose.
19. If all were a single member, where would the body be?
20. As it is, there are many parts, yet one body.
21. The eye cannot say to the hand, “I have no need of you,” nor again the head to the feet, “I have no need of you.”
22. On the contrary, the parts of the body that seem to be weaker are indispensable,
23. and on those parts of the body that we think less honorable we bestow the greater honor, and our unpresentable parts are treated with greater modesty,
24. which our more presentable parts do not require. But God has so composed the body, giving greater honor to the part that lacked it,
25. that there may be no division in the body, but that the members may have the same care for one another.
26. If one member suffers, all suffer together; if one member is honored, all rejoice together.
27. Now you are the body of Christ and individually members of it.

We struggle together united.

Philippians 1:27

27. Most important, live together in a manner worthy of Christ’s gospel. Do this, whether I come and see you or I’m absent and hear about you. Do this so that you stand firm, united in one spirit and mind as you struggle together to remain faithful to the gospel

When 2 or more are gathered he is with them

Matthew 18:19-20

**19 Again I assure you that if two of you agree on earth about anything you ask, then my Father who is in heaven will do it for you.
20 For where two or three are gathered in my name, I'm there with them."**

Asking in his name shall be done

John 14:14

14 When you ask me for anything in my name, I will do it.

Working towards the good of all

Galatians 6:9-10

**9. Let's not get tired of doing good, because in time we'll have a harvest if we don't give up.
10. So then, let's work for the good of all whenever we have an opportunity, and especially for those in the household of faith.**

Lastly we should be praying that all the unsaved would hear the call of Father God. Pray that they would make their decision unhindered by the world or the enemies tactics. Also pray that your fellow brothers and sisters would listen to the Holy spirit convicting them of new sins in their lives they may commit. And let both the saved and unsaved respond to the call and not turn away from it. Let's gather scripture on this as well first is John 6:44 then John 16:7-9 and then Hebrews 3:7-8.

Listen to Father God's call he brings the unsaved to Christ

John 6:44

44. No one can come to me unless they are drawn to me by the Father who sent me, and I will raise them up at the last day.

Listen to the Holy Spirit believers when you sin and repent

John 16:7-9

7. I assure you that it is better for you that I go away. If I don't go away, the Companion won't come to you. But if I go, I will send him to you.

8. When he comes, he will show the world it was wrong about sin, righteousness, and judgment.

9. He will show the world it was wrong about sin because they don't believe in me.

Listen to the call respond to his call

Hebrews 3:7-11

7. So, as the Holy Spirit says,

8. *don't have stubborn hearts, as they did in the rebellion, on the day when they tested me in the desert.*

9. *That is where your ancestors challenged and tested me, though they had seen my work for forty years.*

10 *So I was angry with them. I said, "Their hearts always go off course, and they don't know my ways."*

11. *Because of my anger I swore: "They will never enter my rest!"*

So with all that has been said I'm not telling you to change how you pray. But to add these other ways into your everyday prayers. So that more can be achieved through prayers as it was intended. And to help win the unsaved people for the kingdom of heaven this helps tear strongholds down in their lives making it easier for them to hear Father God's call to begin with. And it helps us as well with our battles

and struggles. And we all still sin from time to time. We are not perfect. Pray for those who do sin who are saved already that they listen to the Holy spirit convicting them to repent.

So remember to put your agreement with others and see what can be accomplished. Take into account everyone's needs, wants and desires as a whole because we are one body. That is all the Holy Spirit at this time wants me to show you. You all have a blessed day to God be the Glory.

Spiritual Edification And The True Reaper

The Holy Spirit has led me to go to the book of John chapter 4 verse 28 through 42 so let's dive right in

John 4:28-42

28. Then the woman left her water jar, went into town, and told the people,
29. "Come, see a man who told me everything I ever did. Could this be the Messiah?"
30. They left the town and made their way to him.
31. In the meantime the disciples kept urging him, "Rabbi, eat something."
32. But he said, "I have food to eat that you don't know about."
33. The disciples said to one another, "Could someone have brought him something to eat?"
34. "My food is to do the will of him who sent me and to finish his work," Jesus told them.
35. "Don't you say, 'There are still four more months, and then comes the harvest'? Listen to what I'm telling you: Open your eyes and look at the fields, because they are ready for harvest.
36. The reaper is already receiving pay and gathering fruit for eternal life, so that the sower and reaper can rejoice together.
37. or in this case the saying is true: 'One sows and another reaps.'
38. I sent you to reap what you didn't labor for; others have labored, and you have benefited from their labor."
39. Now many Samaritans from that town believed in him because of what the woman said when she testified, "He told me everything I ever did."
40. So when the Samaritans came to him, they asked him to stay with them, and he stayed there two days.
41. Many more believed because of what he said.
42. And they told the woman, "We no longer believe because of what you said, since we have heard for ourselves and know that this really is the Savior of the world.

Now in verses 28 and 29 He is using the woman as an example of Christian believers going out into the world and delivering the “Good News”. In verse 30 the believers that came are new Christians and are the ones seeking answers for themselves. In verse 31 the disciples are referring to actual food. That with our senses we can see, touch, taste, and smell. But in verse 32 Jesus Christ is referring to spiritual food. In verse 33 the disciples were confused on what Jesus Christ was saying. They literally thought someone had brought him something to eat while they were in town. In verse 34 he reveals to them what he was talking about. “Spiritual food” and that is doing the will of the Father and what he has you to do in life. That is what spiritual food is. And to be spiritually edified is how you feel after doing what you're called to do. In scripture here are some examples of spiritual food.

Matthew 4:4

4. He answered, “It is written: Man must not live on bread alone but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.”

Deuteronomy 8:3

3. He humbled you by letting you go hungry; then he gave you manna to eat, which you and your ancestors had not known, so that you might learn that man does not live on bread alone but on every word that comes from the mouth of the Lord

Now in verse 35 Jesus is telling us to open our eyes and examine the field. To realize the harvest is ready. He is letting us Christians know the field is ready. For us to get out there in the world and win souls. And that the Harvest is souls and the world is the field. In verse 36 the reaper is not death what modern day man has made it out to be. But King Jesus Christ himself, and the sower is you and me the followers of Christ.

Any person that is out there testifying about him and his love and what he did on the cross willingly for you and me... And that on the third day he rose from the grave, Verse 37 states that one sows and the other reaps. What benefit do we gain by being the reaper? Nothing I tell you we are not the reapers that modern day Christianity has led us to believe. Jesus Christ is. He is the one we are doing this for anyways and his Kingdom.

Sowing is winning the lost, professing the good news, true worship as well. This is all spiritual food. These are all different ways of doing what the Lord has called us to do. To be spiritually edified is how you feel after you have done this is the reward [the reap]. The reaper is Jesus Christ; he is the one receiving the reward of our fruits and labors of sowing. The book of Revelation confirms this in chapter 14.

Revelation 14:14

14 Then I looked, and there was a white cloud, and one like the Son of Man was seated on the cloud, with a golden crown on his head and a sharp sickle in his hand.

Verse 38 means there are people in the world that reject teaching from others and God [Jesus Christ] has sent you to reach them. The foundation has already been laid by hearing the Word. But he is using you to reach them as it was originally intended. The foundation is the other person's labor to reach the lost that was unsuccessful. Now verse 39 is an example of christians today when we testify to others about Christ and what he has done in our lives. These are our testimonies that we tell one another. What God has done in our own lives and why we follow him. Verse 40 is the unbelievers that choose to follow Christ after hearing testimonies of believers. Verse 41 is an example of the Holy Spirit teaching us after we have accepted him into our lives as our Lord. Verse 42 is an example of the New born Christians growing and maturing in faith. That it's not our words they follow but God's word. And that Jesus Christ came to be the savior of this world and he is.

Do we have to physically attend a church house or not?

So the Holy Spirit has laid it upon me to bring some light to this question. The church house is a place where you can go to worship Jesus Christ. That is their exact function to allow fellow Christians a place to go and assemble to worship our Lord. But are they mandatory for Christians to attend them? That is what we will be looking at today. So a lot of people will say yes to this question without seeking further on the matter. Because of one verse and that is Hebrews 10:25. I will be using the CEB translation of the bible for this Lesson.

Hebrew 10:25

25. Don't stop meeting together with other believers, which some people have gotten into the habit of doing. Instead, encourage each other, especially as you see the day drawing near.

With this being said this verse is simply telling you not to stop doing that. Not once does it refer to the Church House as being the only place to assemble. Because it's not the only place where we can assemble to worship and hear the WORD of GOD. There are Home Churches, there are Gatherings in streets. If you're a true Christian you can worship Jesus Christ anywhere. And modern Christianity states that you have to be a part of a church building to be a part of the church. And that is what the Holy Spirit inside me wants to expose. So first of all let's figure out what an assembly is to begin with. An assembly is a gathering of people for a common purpose. Let's see what scripture refers to as assembling. Matthew 18:20 is the verse we will be looking at.

Matthew 18:20

20. For where two or three are gathered in my name, I'm there with them."

Sounds like an assembly is occurring there. Whether it be to correct people or getting together for worship the point is there is an assembling of people coming together for a purpose. Furthermore scripture states that God doesn't reside in a place made by human hands. Acts 17:24 and Acts 7:48 will back this claim up; you

don't have to attend a church house to find Jesus Christ.

Acts 17:24

24. God, who made the world and everything in it, is Lord of heaven and earth. He doesn't live in temples made with human hands.

Acts 7:48

48. However, the Most High doesn't live in houses built by human hands. As the prophet says,

So where does God reside? Well honestly everywhere but there is one place that sticks out and that is inside of me and you the people that accept Jesus Christ as Lord and believe in his Resurrection, the Church. He works through us not a building, you are the church. You are the temple that Christ Jesus resides in. Here are the scriptures to back all this up. 1 Corinthians 3:16, 1 Corinthians 6:19-20, 2 Corinthians 6:16, and Ephesians 2:20-22.

1 Corinthians 3:16

16. Don't you know that you are God's temple and God's Spirit lives in you?

1 Corinthians 6:19-20

19. Or don't you know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you? Don't you know that you have the Holy Spirit from God, and you don't belong to yourselves?

20. You have been bought and paid for, so honor God with your body.

2 Corinthians 6:16

16. What agreement can there be between God's temple and idols? Because we are the temple of the living God. Just as God said, I live with them, and I will move among them. I will be their God, and they will be my people.

Ephesians 2:20-22

20. As God's household, you are built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets with Christ Jesus himself as the cornerstone.

21. The whole building is joined together in him, and it grows up into a temple that is dedicated to the Lord.

22. Christ is building you into a place where God lives through the Spirit.

So to answer the question, no you do not have to attend a Church House to be a Christian and to be obedient as long as you are meeting with fellow Christians, anywhere will suffice at home even. Here are some scriptures blessing the home church. Colossians 4:15, Philemon 1:2, 1 Corinthians 16:19

Colossians 4:15

15. Say hello to the brothers and sisters in Laodicea, along with Nympha and the church that meets in her house.

Philemon 1:2

2. Apphia our sister, Archippus our fellow soldier, and the church that meets in your house.

1 Corinthians 16:19

19. The churches in the province of Asia greet you. Aquila and Prisca greet you warmly in the Lord, together with the church that meets in their house.

With all this being said, where is irrelevant as long as you are doing it. And by doing means associating with your brothers and sisters the followers of Christ. You could meet in the streets, at Home, or the Church house. It's irrelevant where as long as you are doing it. Amen and God Bless you

Fallen angels and false teachers among us today

So for this lesson the Holy Spirit has led me to go to the book of Matthew. We will be looking at chapter 24 and verses 37, 38, and 39. We will learn today what to expect in the end days. So let's begin also i will be using the CSB translation for this lesson

The example given on how things will be when Jesus Returns

Matthew 24:37-39 CSB

37. As the days of Noah were, so the coming of the Son of Man will be.

38. For in those days before the flood they were eating and drinkin marrying and giving in marriage, until the day Noah boarded the ark.

39 .They didn't know until the flood came and swept them all awa This is the way the coming of the Son of Man will be.

Christ Jesus is literally giving you an example of what to expect in the end days. He refers to them being just like they were in the days of Noah. That they were partying, marrying, and giving themselves in marriage. Noah's generation was corrupted by fallen angels (the sons of God) marrying the daughters of man. They bore offspring which were the famous men, Men of renown, powerful men of old. They were a wicked generation and God shortened our life span because of it. This generation was so wicked God regretted making man on the earth. So wicked he chose to flood the earth. Let's jump to Genesis and get the scriptures on this.

This was showing us what was in the past

Genesis 6: 2-6,11,and17 CSB

2. the sons of God saw that the daughters of mankind were beautiful, and they took any they chose as wives for themselves.

3. And the Lord said, “My Spirit will not remain with mankind forever, because they are corrupt. Their days will be 120 years.”

4. The Nephilim were on the earth both in those days and afterward, when the sons of God came to the daughters of mankind, who bore children to them. They were the powerful men of old, the famous men.

5. When the Lord saw that human wickedness was widespread on the earth and that every inclination of the human mind was nothing but evil all the time,

6. the Lord regretted that he had made man on the earth, and he was deeply grieved.

11 Now the earth was corrupt in God’s sight, and the earth was filled with wickedness

17 “Understand that I am bringing a flood—floodwaters on earth to destroy every creature under heaven with the breath of life in it. Everything on earth will perish.

So you see how corrupt the world was back then that is what Jesus was referring to and how Evil and wicked that generation was. In the book of ecclesiastes it is made known. That the things in the past will happen again that there is nothing new under the sun. Therefore also supporting what Jesus had said about the End of days being like Noah’s days. Here is that scripture from ecclesiastes.

The past will happen again

Ecclesiastes 1:9 CSB

9. What has been is what will be, and what has been done is what will be done; there is nothing new under the sun.

Now in the book of Hebrews chapter 13 verse 2 it states: that some of us have welcomed angels without even knowing it.

Humans entertaining angels unaware

Hebrews 13:2 CSB

2. Don't neglect to show hospitality, for by doing this some have welcomed angels as guests without knowing it.

So they can appear however they want. And that we would not even be able to tell the difference between us and them. With that being said a fallen angel is still an angel. Being an angel they can do this as well. Now we are going to the book of Jude. To discuss the ways that they have infiltrated our lives.

The enemies infiltration to our lives and church

Jude 4 and 12 CSB

4. For some people, who were designated for this judgment long ago, have come in by stealth; they are ungodly, turning the grace of our God into sensuality and denying Jesus Christ, our only Master and Lord.

12. These people are dangerous reefs at your love feasts as they eat with you without reverence. They are shepherds who only

look after themselves. They are waterless clouds carried along by winds; trees in late autumn—fruitless, twice dead and uprooted.

So in verse 4 it is talking about the fallen angels. The people designated for judgment long ago are them. It makes us aware they have come in by stealth just like the scripture in Hebrews was stating. Points out how ungodly they are and reveals what they are doing. Turning the grace of our God into sensuality and denying Jesus Christ. Sensuality is the condition of being pleasing or fulfilling to the senses. (Appealing to itchy ears) 2 Timothy chapter 4 verse 3

False teachings in action

2 Timothy 4:3 CSB

3. For the time will come when people will not tolerate sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, will multiply teachers for themselves because they have an itch to hear what they want to hear.

Now in verse 12 of Jude are some of the ways that they have infiltrated. says they are Shepherds which are religious leaders, but also friends, family people you would least expect. In the book of Matthew it states enemies will be members of their own household.

More on the enemies in our lives

Matthew 10:36 CSB

36. and a man's enemies will be the members of his household.

Not to many places left in our lives that they have not infiltrated. Jesus Christ and the disciples were warning us about false prophets, Shepherds,

Pharisees, Sadducees, the so-called legal experts, the studiers of the law. In our terms today we have Pastor, Preachers, Ministers, we still have prophets though. Now of course I'm not referring to all of them but most. Here are the scriptures I was led to on warning us about the false prophets, the Pharisees and the Sadducees. And Jesus Christ referring to their teachings.

Warning on the false teachers

Matthew 7:15 CSB

15. "Be on your guard against false prophets who come to you in sheep's clothing but inwardly are ravaging wolves.

Matthew 24:11 CSB

11. Many false prophets will rise up and deceive many.

Jesus warning us about the Pharisees and Sadducees Pastor and Preachers today

Matthew 16:11-12 CSB

11. Why is it you don't understand that when I told you, 'Beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and Sadducees,' it wasn't about bread?"

12. Then they understood that he had not told them to beware of the leaven in bread, but of the teaching of the Pharisees and Sadducees.

Now we are going to the book of Luke chapter 11 to verses 37 and 52. Jesus had been asked to come eat with the Pharisees so he did and he called them out on them holding the keys to knowledge and pointing out that they had not entered themselves and hindered others from entering. They were teaching their man made doctrines and not the true meaning of what the scripture actually states. He says these people honor me with their lips but their hearts are far from me. Here is the scripture for all of this.

Jesus eating with pharisees and calling them out

Luke 11:37 and 52 CSB

37. As he was speaking, a Pharisee asked him to dine with him. So he went in and reclined at the table.

52. “Woe to you experts in the law! You have taken away the key to knowledge. You didn’t go in yourselves, and you hindered those who were trying to go in.”

About their teaching honoring with their lips but not With their hearts

Matthew 15:8 CSB

8. This people honors me with their lips, but their heart is far from me.

Their teachings being false and not from God

Matthew 15:9

9. They worship me in vain, teaching as doctrines human commands.”

Then in book of Galatians chapter 2 verse 4 tells us just that and why they do it.

Specific infiltration of the church

Galatians 2:4 CSB

4. This matter arose because some false brothers had infiltrated our ranks to spy on the freedom we have in Christ Jesus in order to enslave us.

They are there to spy on us and our freedom we have in Jesus Christ to enslave us. We are free the true followers of Christ Jesus. Romans chapter 6 verse 22 tells you what you have been freed from. Galatians chapter 3 verse 22 states that the enemy wants you back under their control the power of sin as it was before you knew Jesus Christ. The enemy wants to kill, steal, and destroy you says John chapter 10 verse 10.

Being set free from sin (Their control)

Romans 6:22 CSB

22 But now, since you have been set free from sin and have become enslaved to God, you have your fruit, which results in sanctification—and the outcome is eternal life

**This is establishing us being under
there control from the start**

Galatians 3:22 CSB

22 But the Scripture imprisoned everything under sin's power, so that the promise might be given on the basis of faith in Jesus Christ to those who believe.

Their motive in the end their just evil

John 10:10 CSB

10. A thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I have come so that they may have life and have it in abundance.

Now in Galatians chapter 2 verse 5 tells us that the apostles/ the disciples of Christ Jesus when he was on the earth. Did not give up or into these individuals so that the gospel would be preserved in truth for us. And we shouldn't either, we should test everything that we hear and ask the Holy Spirit if it's the truth, He cannot lie, he is the Spirit of Truth. And you should test the spirit to make sure that it is the Holy Spirit and not the spirit of the antichrist. Don't assume that you're hearing the truth when you can know for a fact that it is the truth. Ask the Holy Spirit if it's the truth or not to begin with. Then wait for a reply from the spirit. Then ask the spirit if Jesus Christ has come in the flesh. If you get a yes then it's the Spirit of Truth you get no it's the Spirit of Error.

Proof disciples/apostles didn't give up

Galatians 2:5 CSB

5. But we did not give up and submit to these people for even a moment, so that the truth of the gospel would be preserved for you.

The Holy Spirit being your guide

John 16:13-14

13. When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth. For he will not speak on his own, but he will speak whatever he hears. He will also declare to you what is to come.

14. He will glorify me, because he will take from what is mine and declare it to you.

Discerning the spirits knowing which spirit you are talking to

1 John 4:1-2

1. Dear friends, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see if they are from God, because many false prophets have gone out into the world.

The Spirit of Truth the Holy Spirit

2. This is how you know the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God

The Spirit of Error The Antichrist Spirit

2 John 7

7. Many deceivers have gone out into the world; they do not confess the coming of Jesus Christ in the flesh. This is the deceiver and the antichrist.

This will help you learn his voice so that you don't get led astray. How do you know your master's voice? If you're not trained to hear it! This is the training to learn his voice. The bible tells that we his people perish for the lack of knowledge. But it also tells us how to receive knowledge and that is to ask God for it. Here are your scriptures for all this.

Knowing the Master's voice and not being deceived

John 10:4-5 CSB

4. When he has brought all his own outside, he goes ahead of them. The sheep follow him because they know his voice.

5. They will never follow a stranger; instead they will run away from him, because they don't know the voice of strangers."

Perishing for lack of knowledge

Hosea 5:6 CSB

6. My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge. Because you have rejected knowledge, I will reject you from serving as my priest. Since you have forgotten the law of your God, I will also forget your sons.

Knowledge freely given just ask God for it

James 1:5 CSB

5 Now if any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God—who gives to all generously and ungrudgingly—and it will be given to him.

So there you have it, seek him in all things for the truth. Why be deceived if you don't have to be. But at this time if there are any unbelievers who want to accept Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior. This is all you have to do is say it with your mouth that Jesus Christ is Lord. And believe it and that he died on the cross and that God raised him from the dead; and YOU WILL BE SAVED. Then ask for forgiveness of your sins and turn away from them. That's what repentance is and ask God to help you with the ones

you commit so you don't keep committing them. We are humans, we die each and every day no matter our age. We get in accidents, pass from sickness and disease, and we are not promised tomorrow at all. And if you die and still have sin in your life you will take your place in the lake of fire. So please listen to the Warning Repent of your sins accept Jesus in your life as your Lord. That's wisdom my friends every step is laid out in front of you all you have to do is act. And this is how you start your journey with him, this is where you pick up your cross and follow him. And here is the scriptures for all of this.

Accepting Jesus Christ for who he is and believing in what he did

Romans 10:9 CSB

9. If you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

Repent of your sins

Acts 3:19 CSB

19. Therefore repent and turn back, so that your sins may be wiped out.

**Tomorrow not being promised
So repent while you can**

James 4:14 CSB

14 Yet you do not know what tomorrow will bring—what your life will be! For you are like vapor that appears for a little while, then vanishes.

Asking in my name

JESUS CHRIST

So for this lesson the Holy Spirit has led me to go to the book of John. We will be looking at John chapter 14 verses 13 and 14. He wanted me to talk to you today about asking for things in his name. And to understand who it is you're asking to begin with. I will be using the CEB translation for this lesson as well.

Asking anything in my name

John 14: 13-14 CEB

13. I will do whatever you ask for in my name, so that the Father can be glorified in the Son.

14. When you ask me for anything in my name, I will do it.

I want to point out that his name is Jesus but most don't understand what he is actually meaning in this scripture. Jesus was more than just any human; his Mother was Human and his father is God. So therefore you need to understand who he is. Yes his first name is Jesus but also his last name was Christ. And we are told exactly what the meaning of Christ is and that he is the Son of the Living God. So yes the name is his name but who does the name of Jesus refer to when we say it. It can literally be anyone in existence that was named Jesus. So the way to Establish exactly who you are talking about and asking to begin with needs to be in his full name Jesus Christ. It even tells you why it needs to be his full name. And that is so that the father can be glorified in the son. So how does God get the glory in this

manner when you acknowledge that Jesus Christ is the son of God. The exact meaning of Christ that scripture gives us is in Matthew chapter 16 verse 16 let's go there now and see what it says in the scripture.

Matthew 16:16 CEB

16. Simon Peter said, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."

And that literally states exactly what I have told you. I also want to point out that most of the time the apostles referred to Jesus as. Christ, Jesus Christ, Lord Christ, and Christ Jesus. And the bible also gives us examples of others that were named Jesus. Let's see the examples that are given.

Colossians 4:11 CEB

11. Jesus, called Justus, also says hello. These are my only fellow workers for God's kingdom who are Jewish converts. They have been an encouragement to me.

Matthew 27:16 CEB

16 At that time there was a well-known prisoner named Jesus Barabbas.

There are the two examples the Holy Spirit led me to. So that you could see this. And is showing you why you establish who you are referring to. Anyone on this earth can be named Jesus. But there is only one who is referred to as the SON of GOD and that is Jesus Christ. Our next verse confirms every bit of what I have told you.

Philippians 2:11

11. and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

So there you have it when you confess that Jesus Christ is lord the Glory goes to God his father, whose son is Jesus Christ. With all this being said when asking in his name Jesus Christ. You are acknowledging him as the Son of God and it states he will do whatever it is you ask in his name. So I know a lot of us have asked for things to be done and that a lot of prayers go unanswered. And a lot of it has to do with us asking in the name of Jesus. So the next time you have something that you want. Ask Jesus Christ the son of God to establish first who you are asking the thing for then Ask it in his name. Scripture states he will honor them so that the glory will be given to God the Father. So there you have it honor God by honoring His Son Jesus Christ.

Day and Night....Grace Before Wrath

Lesson to my son 10-27-23 who was saved in March 2023

So for today's lesson the Holy Spirit has led me to go to the book of John chapter 11 verse 9 and 10. So at this time let's open our Bibles and dive right in. I will be using the CSB translation for this lesson today.

John 11:9-10 CSB

9. "Aren't there twelve hours in a day?" Jesus answered. "If anyone walks during the day, he doesn't stumble, because he sees the light of this world.

10. But if anyone walks during the night, he does stumble, because the light is not in him."

So let's discuss the matter in depth a little bit. So when Jesus was referring to the time of grace. That this is the time God has allowed for people to easily find Jesus Christ and Repent and leave in the rapture not after.

Scripture tells us as well that God is long suffering and patient to allow as many possible to come to repentance before wrath. Here is the scripture for that.

2 Peter 3:9 CSB

9. The Lord does not delay his promise, as some understand delay, but is patient with you not wanting any to perish but all to come to repentance.

Now back to John 11:9. The rest of this scripture is referring to how much easier it is to find Jesus Christ the Light of the World. The day is (the period of grace.) And Jesus resides inside all of us, the ones who choose to follow Him. The light that the unbeliever can see in our present time is you and me, the followers of Christ. The light will not be appointed to wrath. The light will only be here so long in the world then Jesus will come get us. And here is the scriptures on this.

Jesus Christ being the light of the world.

John 8:12 CSB

12. Jesus spoke to them again: "I am the Light of the World. Anyone who follows me will never walk in the darkness but will have the light of life."

Jesus Christ Residing In His Followers

John 14:20

20. On that day you will know that I am in the Father, you are in me, and I am in you

Colossians 1:27

27. God wanted to make known among the gentiles the glorious wealth of the mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.

Us being the light in the world at this time

Matthew 5:14-16

14. "You are the light of the world. A city situated on a hill cannot be hidden.

15. No one lights a lamp and puts it under a basket, but rather on a lampstand, and it gives light for all who are in the house.

16. In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father in heaven.

The light not being appointed to wrath

(You and me followers of Christ)

of Rapture

1 Thessalonians 5: 2, 9

2. For you yourselves know very well that the day of the Lord will come like a thief in the night

9. For God did not appoint us to wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ

This Is the Rapture in action when the light Is gone

Revelation 14:14-16

14. Then I looked, and there was a white cloud, and one like the Son of Man was seated on the cloud, with a golden crown on his head and a sharp sickle in his hand.

15. Another angel came out of the temple, crying out in a loud voice to the one who was seated on the cloud, "Use your sickle and reap, for the time to reap has come, since the harvest of the earth is ripe."

16. So the one seated on the cloud swung his sickle over the earth, and the earth was harvested.

Now back to John 11:10 in this scripture Jesus is making us aware of how hard it will be for the unbeliever to accept Christ and find the light is gone. That's why they stumble without the light (us) to help. The light is gone from this world because it was raptured. The Night is referring to the (a period of wrath.)

But even though the light is gone it is not impossible there will be people on the earth at this time who do find Jesus and they will be the light. But they will have the antichrist to deal with.

Persecuting the saints, the followers of Christ at this time, and killing anyone who does not accept the mark of the beast. This itself will make it harder to find Christ because the light will continually be persecuted as well. Here is the scripture on that.

Wrath is coming

Colossians 3:6 CSB

6. Because of these, God's wrath is coming upon the disobedient

For nothing is impossible for God

Luke 1:37 CSB

37. For nothing will be impossible with God.

Luke 18:27 CSB

27. He replied, "What is impossible with man is possible with God."

The christians at this time becoming the light

John 9:5 CSB

5. As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world."

2 Corinthians 13:5 CSB

5. Test yourselves to see if you are in the faith. Examine yourselves. Or do you yourselves not recognize that Jesus Christ is in you?—Unless you fail the test.

Ephesians 5:8 CSB

8. For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light

Persecution of the Saints and the killing of those who do not accept the mark

Revelation 13:7 and 15 CSB

7. And it was permitted to wage war against the saints and to conquer them. It was also given authority over every tribe, people, language, and nation.

15. It was permitted to give breath to the image of the beast, so that the image of the beast could both speak and cause whoever would not worship the image of the beast to be killed.

So my suggestion to anyone who has not been saved, and repented of sins. See this warning, God will only be patient so much longer the period of Grace will end one day. And you don't want to be here when God's period of wrath occurs. So confess now that Jesus is Lord, believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead and **YOU WILL BE SAVED**.

Repent of your sins means asking for forgiveness and to turn away from your sins. Not only is wrath coming **NO ONE** knows when they will die and if you die before you do this you go to **HELL** plain and simple. This is not a scare tactic; its wisdom **GOD'S WORD** cannot lie. And here is your scriptures for all this.

Accepting Jesus as Lord

Romans 10:9 CSB

9. If you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

Repentance

Acts 3:19 CSB

John 16:13-14

¹³ Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.

¹⁴ He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew it unto you.

*****If you're feeling "led" to do something you need to test, try, and discern as the Word of God says to do and ensure if this is what Father God and Jesus Christ wants you to do. The problem is that we hardly ever know enough of the behind-the-scenes activity to make either a correct rational, or biblical-based, decision. And we don't need to know. God knows.

Verses about trying, to test, prove, and discern all things:

1 John 4:1; 1 Thessalonians 5:21; Job 12:11; Romans 12:2; Philippians 1:9; Acts 17:11

*****Still everything must line up with the Holy Word of God. Here is what it says about being led or walking by the Spirit.

Romans 8:¹⁴ For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.

Galatians 5:16-18; 22-26

¹⁶ This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh.

¹⁷ For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would.

¹⁸ But if ye be led of the Spirit, ye are not under the law.

²² But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith,

²³ Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.

²⁴ And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts.

²⁵ If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.

*****Jesus Christ is our example (1 Peter 2:21) of how we are to live a holy and pleasing life to Father God and to one day make Heaven our home. Jesus Christ Himself was led into the wilderness by the Spirit, the Holy Spirit when He was tempted by the devil.

Matthew 4:1 Then was Jesus led up of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil.

*****Another example was Philip.

Acts 8:²⁹ Then the Spirit said unto Philip, Go near, and join thyself to this chariot.

Jesus Christ was led by the Holy Ghost Spirit.

Luke 4:1 And Jesus being full of the Holy Ghost returned from Jordan, and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness,

*****The Holy Spirit is the power of God that comes inside us so we can do all we are called to do in Jesus Christ's Name in addition to having the power of the Word of God.

Acts 1:8 But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

Romans 8:11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.

*****Not only do you have to be led by His sweet Holy Spirit you also need to know the Word of God. It takes both because the Holy Spirit will lead you to the truth of the Word of God revealing and giving understating of its truth. Remember Jesus Christ is the Word made into flesh. (John 1:1; 14) Here are a few things concerning the Word of God.

*****Write the Word on our hearts and teach it to our children.

Deuteronomy 11:8-20

¹⁸ Therefore shall ye lay up these my words in your heart and in your soul, and bind them for a sign upon your hand, that they may be as frontlets between your eyes.

¹⁹ And ye shall teach them your children, speaking of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, when thou liest down, and when thou risest up.

²⁰ And thou shalt write them upon the door posts of thine house, and upon thy gates:

*****Study it for understanding

2 Timothy 2:¹⁵ Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

*****The Word will guide our path lighting our way in a dark world.

Psalms 119:104-105

¹⁰⁴ Through thy precepts I get understanding: therefore I hate every false way.

¹⁰⁵ Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.

The Word of God is a faith builder.

Romans 10:¹⁷ So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

*****It's given to us for everything we need.

2 Timothy 3:16-17

¹⁶ All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:

¹⁷ That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.

*****It's part of our Holy Armor

Ephesians 6:10-18

¹⁰ Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might.

¹¹ Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

¹² For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

¹³ Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

¹⁴ Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness;

¹⁵ And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace;

¹⁶ Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.

¹⁷ And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:

¹⁸ Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;

****Jesus Christ the Word made into flesh

John 1:1; 14

1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

14 And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

*****What does this all mean? It means we have to be led by and walk in the Holy Spirit in the knowledge of the Word of God in our lives everyday. He will guide us and teach us. Give us divine understanding by submitting to Him as our teacher. He will teach us to all truth including all about Jesus Christ who is truth itself. (John 14:6; 26; 16:13; 1 John 2:27) He's our Comforter and will lead us how to pray and also intercedes for us. Again if we allow sweet Holy Spirit to lead us.

Romans 8:26-27

²⁶ Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.

²⁷ And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God.

*****It takes Jesus Christ in our hearts working in unity with the Holy Spirit and the Spirit operates in the power of God for us to be all we are called to be in Jesus Christ. We see the evidence of the power of God working through the sweet Holy Spirit in the miracles and wonders done by Jesus Christ once he was baptized by the Spirit. As well as the evidence in the disciples and apostles. (Matthew 12:28; Acts 2:43; 3:1-7; 9:39-41)

*****So each of us who calls Jesus Christ our Lord (without deception) can operate in the fullness of God. In the power of the Godhead that rested inside Jesus Christ but we need to study and understand the Word of God and be led by the Spirit working together as one. You need both because both are truth.

Colossians 2:9-10

⁹For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily.

¹⁰And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power:

Colossians 1:19 For it pleased the Father that in him should all fulness dwell;

1 John 5:7-8

⁷For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one.

⁸And there are three that bear witness in earth, the Spirit, and the water, and the blood: and these three agree in one.

*****Verses about Holy Spirit, Father God, and Jesus Christ living inside us.

1 Corinthians 6:19-20

¹⁹What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?

²⁰For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

1 John 4:¹²No man hath seen God at any time. If we love one another, God dwelleth in us, and his love is perfected in us.

Galatians 2:²⁰I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.

*****We need both the Spirit and Word of God to try, test, prove and discern all things. Before you act or react to something even if there appears to be Biblical reasons and justification in which you could proceed, stop and ask sweet Holy Spirit. Pray about it in Jesus Christ's Name. You need to seek the Holy Spirit's leading (He's the Spirit of Truth) always to aid in discerning and seeking in Jesus Christ's Name how to proceed in everything and situation. Again because He knows the whole situation and we have only one or two pieces.

Please pray about this, try, test it in Jesus Christ's Name.

Training your ears to hear and know his voice (CEB Translation)

So today the Holy Spirit has laid it upon my heart. To discuss with you how to train your ears to hear his voice; and to know that it is him that you are talking to. God (Jesus Christ) wants us to have a relationship with him. But how do you do that without knowing his voice to communicate with him to begin with. God has given you the very questions to ask the spirits to know. So let's begin ask the Holy Spirit, God, or Jesus Christ whatever it is you want to know. Wait for an answer. They are not always loud but an answer will be given. After this you will need to test the spirits to know who they are and who they serve. The Bible tells us not to believe every spirit that we hear. But to test them and see if they are of God or not. And how you do this is to [ask the spirit that is communicating with you, did Jesus Christ come as a Human \(come in the flesh for other bible readers KJV,CSB\)](#). If the spirit confesses or says yes that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh then it is of God. If it denies, says no or confesses that Jesus Christ did not come in the flesh it's of the devil (the deceiver) or the antichrist (the spirit of error). And if you want reassurance that this spirit is of God still. Find out who it serves by [asking the spirit if Jesus Christ is its Lord](#). If it serves the Lord Jesus Christ it has the Holy spirit and will say yes. If it says no the spirit does not serve Jesus Christ and does not have the Holy Spirit. Because nothing can profess this if they do not have the Holy Spirit. This is exactly what Jesus was referring to in the Scriptures about sheep knowing his voice and another they will not follow. This is the training for you to know how to hear, who to follow, and who to ignore. Let's get all the scriptures to back this up.

The Word confirming to not believe in every spirit but test them see if they are of God

1 John 4:1 CEB

1. Dear friends, don't believe every spirit. Test the spirits to see if they are from God because many false prophets have gone into the world.

Testing of the spirits section:

Whom to follow the good shepherd's voice

1 John 4:2 CEB

2 This is how you know if a spirit comes from God: every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come as a human[a] is from God.

Who to ignore any other voice that's not his

2 John verse 7 CEB

7. Many deceivers have gone into the world who do not confess that Jesus Christ came as a human being. This kind of person is the deceiver and the antichrist.

Finding out who the spirit serves:

No one can say Jesus Christ is there Lord
without the Holy Spirit.
(Yes including spirits)

1 Corinthians 12:3 CEB

3 So I want to make it clear to you that no one says, “**Jesus is cursed!**” when speaking by God’s Spirit, and no one can say, “**Jesus is Lord,**” except by the Holy Spirit.

The red serves the Antichrist: **Denies that He is their Lord.**

The blue serves Jesus Christ: **Accepts and professes that Jesus Christ is their Lord.**

Following the Good shepherd (Jesus Christ) and knowing his voice

John 10:27 CEB

27 My sheep listen to my voice. I know them and they follow me.

John 10:4 CEB

4 Whenever he has gathered all of his sheep, he goes before them and they follow him, because they know his voice.

Ignoring and running away from the strangers voice (the deceiver and the antichrist)

John 10:5 CEB

5 They won't follow a stranger but will run away because they don't know the stranger's voice."

So there you have it you folks. Everything that you need to know to start communicating with your creator. Build that relationship by communication and know his voice. This is exactly how you do that so that you the sheep are not led astray. The End.

What is Self-Condernation?

So the Holy Spirit has laid this topic on my heart and would like to discuss this with you today. Let's dive into this topic and understand what it is to begin with and how the enemy uses this against us. So what is Self-Condernation? Self-Condernation is a tactic the enemy uses against us. It is used to make us think that we are unworthy and not forgiven for the actions of our past when we lived a life in sin. But that surely is not the case when you accept Jesus Christ as your Lord and you Repent of your sins all is forgiven. So brothers and sisters don't dwindle on things that are forgiven and realize the difference of conviction and condernation. Conviction is for your benefit when we do wrong. It's simply the Holy Spirit making you aware that your actions were wrong and you need to repent. Self-Condernation is the enemy using something from your past to condemn you into believing that you're not forgivable. **So have faith that you are forgiven, don't let doubt have any access to work in your life.** When you give into condernation you allow doubt to enter therefore giving the enemy control to keep you bound who the Savior Lord Jesus Christ has set free. We are at war with principalities, our own fleshly desires, and the whole kingdom of darkness; these are just one of the many tactics they use. Father God through his word has made us aware of all the enemies tactics and how to defend ourselves from them. He even gives you a set of armour to protect yourselves. With all this being said let's go to scripture and apply the scripture to our lives and not fall to condernation anymore. And realize what it means to be free. And the peace that is granted from being forgiven and resting assured that we are. First we will look at some examples of people going through self condernation. I will be using the CEB translation as well for these scriptures. First example is Judas Iscariot after he betrayed our Lord Jesus Christ he repented and gave the 30 pieces of silver back but he ultimately gave into self-condernation believing he was

not redeemable and took his own life.

Matthew 27:3-5

3. When Judas, who betrayed Jesus, saw that Jesus was condemned to die, he felt deep regret. He returned the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders, and

4. said, "I did wrong because I betrayed an innocent man." But they said, "What is that to us? That's your problem."

5. Judas threw the silver pieces into the temple and left. Then he went and hanged himself.

The next example is Isaiah condemning himself saying he was unworthy and unclean unfit for the task and role that he was being called to do. But he ended up having faith and was obedient becoming a powerful voice for our Lord.

Isaiah 6:5-8

5. I said, "Mourn for me; I'm ruined! I'm a man with unclean lips, and I live among a people with unclean lips. Yet I've seen the king, the LORD of heavenly forces!"

6. Then one of the winged creatures flew to me, holding a glowing coal that he had taken from the altar with tongs.

7. He touched my mouth and said, "See, this has touched your lips. Your guilt has departed, and your sin is removed."

8. Then I heard the Lord's voice saying, "Whom should I send, and who will go for us?" I said, "I'm here; send me."

And our last example I am going to use is the woman at the well. She expressed self-condemnation when she felt judged and rejected by society due to her past choices and actions. And Jesus showed her hope and forgiveness and freedom from her sins that condemn her.

John 4:7-26

7. A Samaritan woman came to the well to draw water. Jesus said to her, "Give me some water to drink."

8. His disciples had gone into the city to buy him some food.

9. The Samaritan woman asked, "Why do you, a Jewish man, ask for something to drink from me, a Samaritan woman?" (Jews and Samaritans didn't associate with each other.)

10. Jesus responded, "If you recognized God's gift and who is saying to you, 'Give me some water to drink,' you would be asking him and he would give you living water."

11. The woman said to him, "Sir, you don't have a bucket and the well is deep. Where would you get this living water?"

12. You aren't greater than our father Jacob, are you? He gave this well to us, and he drank from it himself, as did his sons and his livestock."

13. Jesus answered, "Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again,

14. but whoever drinks from the water that I will give will never be thirsty again. The water that I give will become in those who drink it a spring of water that bubbles up into eternal life."

15. The woman said to him, "Sir, give me this water, so that I will never be thirsty and will never need to come here to draw water!"

16. Jesus said to her, “Go, get your husband, and come back here.”

17. The woman replied, “I don’t have a husband.”“You are right to say, ‘I don’t have a husband,’” Jesus answered.

18. “You’ve had five husbands, and the man you are with now isn’t your husband. You’ve spoken the truth.”

19. The woman said, “Sir, I see that you are a prophet.

20. Our ancestors worshipped on this mountain, but you and your people say that it is necessary to worship in Jerusalem.”

21. Jesus said to her, “Believe me, woman, the time is coming when you and your people will worship the Father neither on this mountain nor in Jerusalem.

22. You and your people worship what you don’t know; we worship what we know because salvation is from the Jews.

23. But the time is coming—and is here!—when true worshippers will worship in spirit and truth. The Father looks for those who worship him this way.

24. God is spirit, and it is necessary to worship God in spirit and truth.”

25. The woman said, “I know that the Messiah is coming, the one who is called the Christ. When he comes, he will teach everything to us.”

26. Jesus said to her, “I Am—the one who speaks with you.”

So those are just a few of the examples given in the Word of people dealing with self-condemnation. But the word gives us reassurance that when we accept JESUS CHRIST as our Lord and we repent of our past sins all is forgiven. When you accept him

you change your heart and life the old you dies and is reborn a new creation. And when you repent you acknowledge that you were in the wrong and turn away from sin. Let's see what scripture says to back this up. Starting with the acceptance of Lord Jesus Christ into your life.

Romans 10:9-11

9. Because if you confess with your mouth "Jesus is Lord" and in your heart you have faith that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

10. Trusting with the heart leads to righteousness, and confessing with the mouth leads to salvation.

11. The scripture says, *All who have faith in him won't be put to shame*

After you have done this you need to repent of your sins. Simply confessing that you have done wrong and acknowledge it. Confessions of sins are between you and God. Man can forgive with our hearts and words. But God grants you peace and true forgiveness through repentance. These are the steps to take to truly change your hearts and lives that Jesus Christ shed his blood for. So here is some more beautiful scripture to back this up as well.

Act 3:19

19. Change your hearts and lives! Turn back to God so that your sins may be wiped away.

Mark 1:15

15. saying, "Now is the time! Here comes God's kingdom! Change your hearts and lives, and trust this good news!"

Psalms 51:1-4

1. Have mercy on me, God, according to your faithful love! Wipe away my wrongdoings according to your great compassion!

2. Wash me completely clean of my guilt; purify me from my sin!
3. Because I know my wrongdoings, my sin is always right in front of me.
4. I've sinned against you—you alone. I've committed evil in your sight. That's why you are justified when you render your verdict, completely correct when you issue your judgment.

Ephesians 1:7-8

7. We have been ransomed through his Son's blood, and we have forgiveness for our failures based on his overflowing grace, 8. which he poured over us with wisdom and understanding.

Now you need to put your faith and believe that God will do for you as his word says. And it says to not doubt and have faith. But to believe in the promise and the good news about his son. Have faith, and don't doubt. Some more scripture telling us to have faith and not doubt.

James 1:6-8

6. Whoever asks shouldn't hesitate. They should ask in faith, without doubting. Whoever doubts is like the surf of the sea, tossed and turned by the wind.
7. People like that should never imagine that they will receive anything from the Lord.
8. They are double-minded, unstable in all their ways.

So don't doubt don't give them access or room to work in your life. We are at war with the kingdom of darkness . But GOD prepares us and gives us the tools to defend ourselves. And he has given us this knowledge to make us aware of their devices and schemes. Lets see what scripture says about this.

Ephesians 4:27

27. Don't provide an opportunity for the devil.

Ephesians 6:10-17

10. Finally, be strengthened by the Lord and his powerful strength. 11. Put on God's armor so that you can make a stand against the tricks of the devil.

12. We aren't fighting against human enemies but against rulers, authorities, forces of cosmic darkness, and spiritual powers of evil in the heavens.

13. Therefore, pick up the full armor of God so that you can stand your ground on the evil day and after you have done everything possible to still stand.

14. So stand with the belt of truth around your waist, justice as your breastplate,

15. and put shoes on your feet so that you are ready to spread the good news of peace. 16. Above all, carry the shield of faith so that you can extinguish the flaming arrows of the evil one.

17. Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is God's word.

2 Corinthians 2:11

11. This is so that we won't be taken advantage of by Satan, because we are well aware of his schemes.

Father God has been so gracious and he will reassure you that you will receive peace and understanding. And I want you to understand when Jesus sets you free you are free. It's in his word and he doesn't do anything halfway. Let see what it says.

Philippians 4:7

7. Then the peace of God that exceeds all understanding will keep your

hearts and minds safe in Christ Jesus.

John 8:36

36. Therefore, if the Son makes you free, you really will be free.

Galatians 5:1

1. Christ has set us free for freedom. Therefore, stand firm and don't submit to the bondage of slavery again.

We will all have to war no matter what, cause the kingdom of darkness wants us to fail just like they have. But you are covered and blessed and God loves us. I hope this helps you with understanding and learning to be aware of yet another enemy tactic. And how to prepare yourself and not give into the enemies tricks and schemes. That is all I have.
